1. **Kumbharbhali Check Dam** - Sabalpur, Raipur, Pali, Raj.
2. **Jujhar Check Dam** - Bakhtawarpura, Jaitaran, Pali, Raj.
3. **Ramdev Check Dam** - Richhmaliya, Pisangan, Ajmer, Raj.
4. **Gulab Check Dam** - Shrigadh, Jaitaran, Beawar, Raj.
5. **Heera Check Dam** - Semaliya, Bichchhiwada, Dungarpur, Raj.
6. **Saleda Check Dam** - Saleda, Chikhli, Dungarpur, Raj.
7. **Vaza Check Dam** - Lamba-Bhatda, Bichchhiwada, Dungarpur, Raj.





Team Visit (April 2024)



They are very optimistic about the benefits of the check dam, having observed its positive impact over the past few years, as well as in nearby villages.
